The new national charity for the civic movement in England is looking for up to **8 trustees** (including **chair** and **treasurer**) to form a new governing body from April 2010

**Civic Voice** works to make the places where everyone lives more attractive, enjoyable and distinctive. Civic Voice promotes civic pride. Civic Voice will be launched on Saturday 17 April and is being set up following closure of the Civic Trust in April 2009. There are more than 1,000 civic societies with over 250,000 members in the civic movement.
